Patient Instructions- Skin Pick Allergy Testing

We require a minimum of 48-hour cancellation notice for skin prick allergy appointments.

The testing will last for approximately one hour. Please allow this time and wear a short sleeve shirt.

Pediatric Patients (younger than 12): Patient will be prescribed EMLA cream to numb back prior to skin prick testing. Patient should have EMLA cream placed on entire back approximately 2 hours prior to testing and wrap patient's back in saran wrap. The saran wrap will allow the medication to be the most effective. If you did not receive a prescription, please call clinic and notify immediately.

KEY INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALLERGY SKIN PRICK TESTING

- Please read below handout carefully to determine what day to stop antihistamines and/or
 other prescription medications! It is VERY IMPORTANT to discuss stopping any medication
 with prescribing provider prior to stopping medication. If you have questions, please
 contact office.
- Patients on Beta Blockers must have their medications reviewed by the allergy department. Patient should not stop taking Beta Blocker, but should review with provider prior to skin prick testing for further instructions.
- Patient may continue to take oral steroids as well as steroid nasal sprays (Flonase, Nasacort)
- If you have been diagnosed with Dermatographism or if your skin "whelps" or makes a hive easily when lightly "scraped", notify the allergy technician <u>BEFORE</u> the testing date.
- If you have asthma, please remind the allergy technician when you are brought into the room for allergy skin prick testing. It is <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u> that we know what your asthma status has been for one week prior to the allergy skin testing as the skin testing can affect your asthma status!
- Please have breakfast or lunch prior to have skin prick allergy testing.
